Money Mule Awareness Campaign

An Comhairle Notes a money mule is an individual who allows their account to be used for the transfer of other's stolen or illegal money.

An Comhairle Further Notes that those aged 18-24, of which many are students, are the most commonly targeted age group by organised crime gangs to act as money mules.

An Comhairle Regrets that penalties for this crime include a prison sentence of up to 14 years, a criminal conviction with a lifetime criminal record, extradition to the country where the predicate crime occurred, and not being permitted to open another bank account.

An Comhairle Mandates the VP for Welfare and VP for Campaigns to run an awareness campaign on the dangers of working as a money mule, particularly for third level students.
